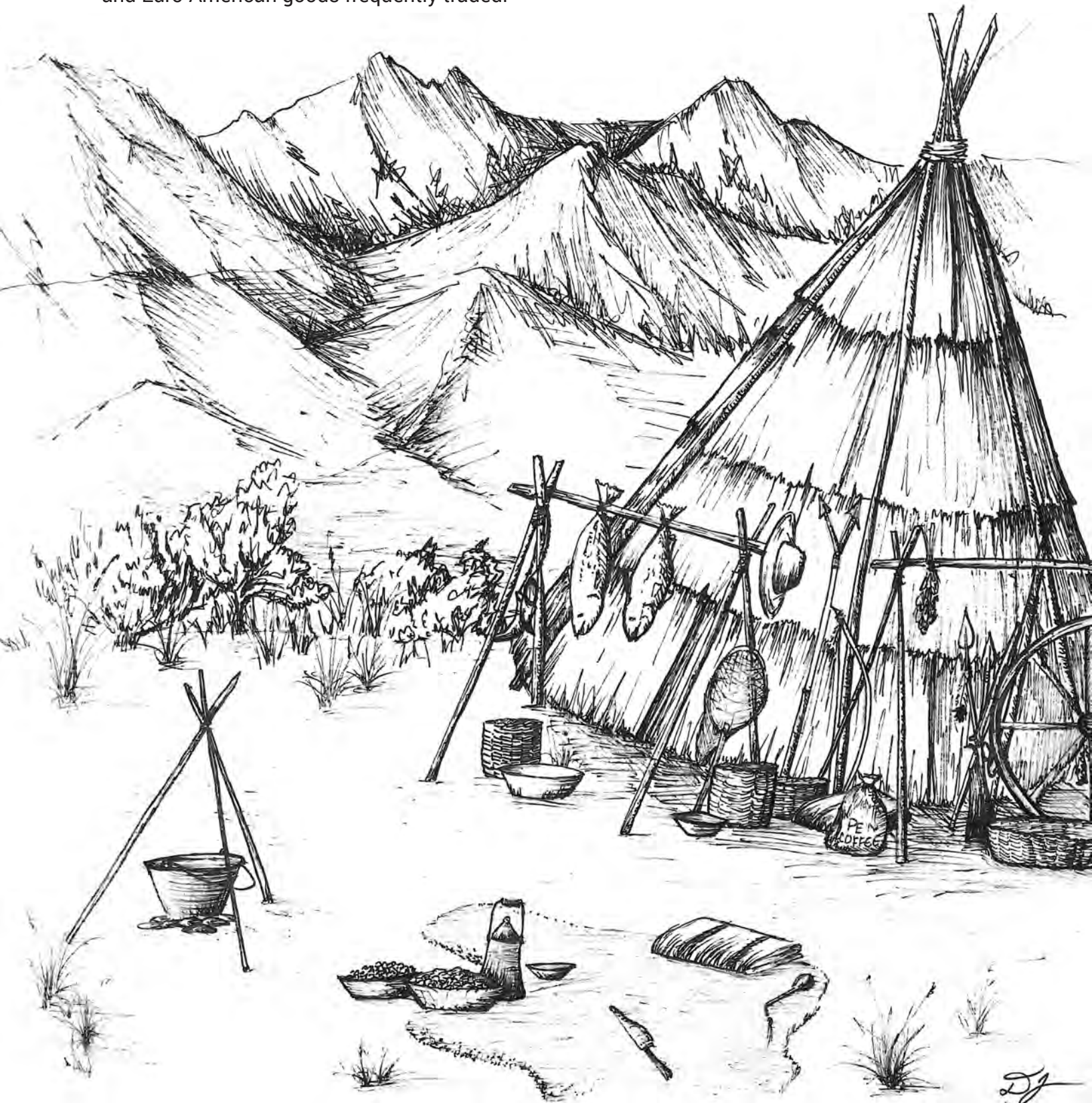


TYPICAL GREAT BASIN-STYLE NATIVE AMERICAN CAMP

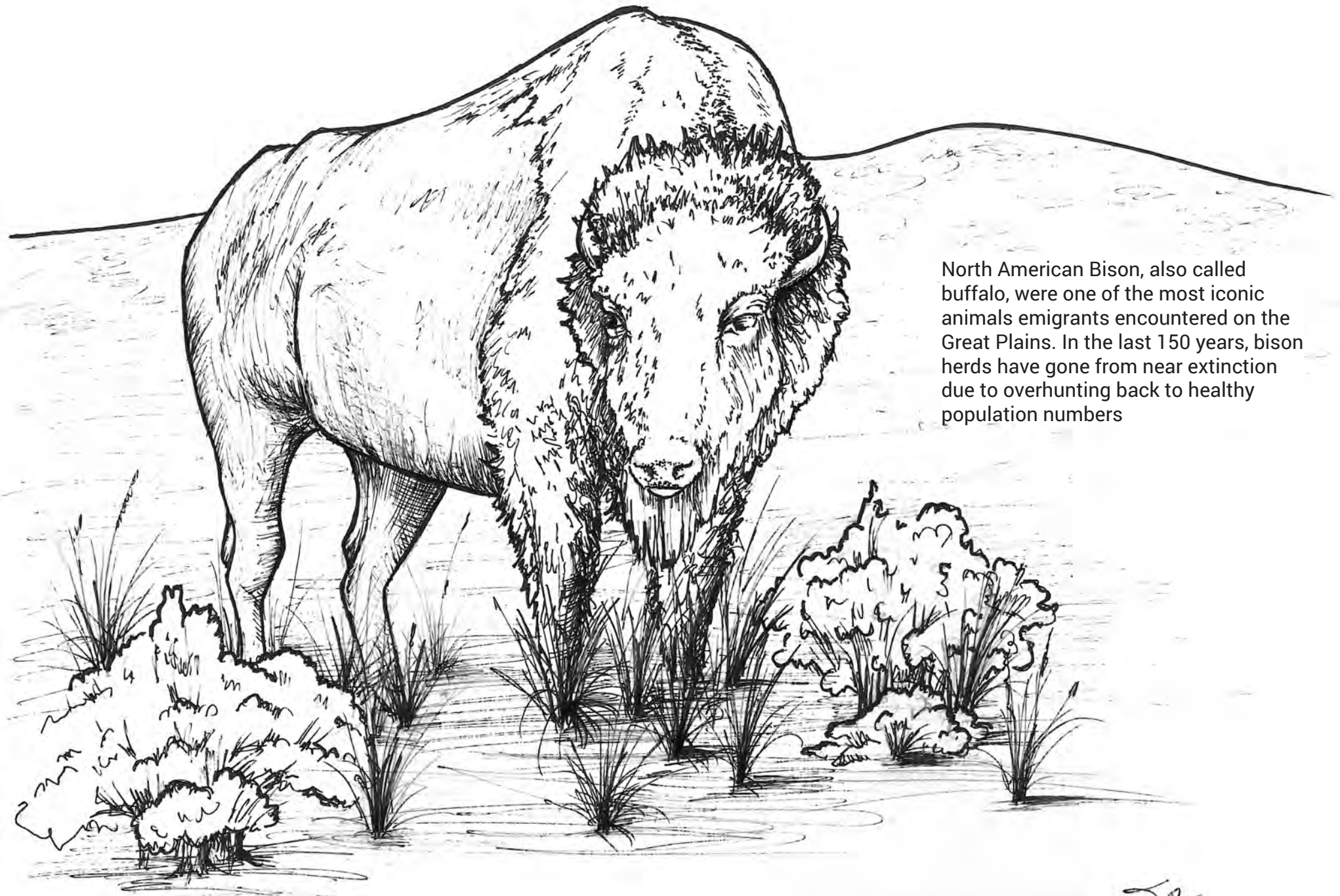

NORTH AMERICAN BISON



North American Bison, also called buffalo, were one of the most iconic animals emigrants encountered on the Great Plains. In the last 150 years, bison herds have gone from near extinction due to overhunting back to healthy population numbers
